The ACJS Student Panel Presentation Awards recognize students who authored outstanding papers to be presented at the upcoming Annual Meeting. This award recognizes students' outstanding research and encourages active participation in the Annual Meeting.

Eligibility criteria: To be eligible for an award, the applicant must:

1. Be enrolled in a graduate or undergraduate program at the time of submission of their application. In cases of multiple co-authors, all co-authors must be students at the time of the application.
2. Submit the abstract of the paper for student panels before the ACJS final abstract submission deadline.
3. Present their paper at the upcoming Annual Meeting.
4. Submit presentation slides in PowerPoint or PDF format and a 10-15 minute pre-recorded video presentation.

Nomination requirements:

1. Self-nominations by applicants are allowed.
2. The applicants do not need to be ACJS members at the time of application.
3. Paper presentations should not be co-authored by faculty.

The subcommittee for this award shall evaluate submissions on the basis of research originality, scientific rigor, and presentation skills. Only nominations that meet the eligibility criteria and nomination requirements will be considered for the award.

The first-place award recipient will receive an award of \$500. The second-place award recipient will receive an award of \$300. The third-place award recipient will receive an award of \$200. If a panel presentation receiving the award is co-authored, the amount of the award will be shared equally among all co-authors.
