The MacNamara Award for Outstanding Journal Publication was created by a donation to ACJS from Dr. Donal MacNamara, one of the Academy of Criminal Justice founding scholars. The purpose of the award is to recognize outstanding scholarship published in one of the publication venues of the Academy (*Justice Quarterly, Journal of Criminal Justice Education, Justice Evaluation Journal* and *ACJS Today*). Articles must:

- 1. Constitute a scholarly approach to the topic.
- 2. Present a thoughtful analysis.
- 3. Present insights or a novel treatment of the topic.
- 4. Constitute a meaningful addition to the literature.
- 5. Have been published in the issues of the three ACJS publications between September 1, 2024 and August 31, 2025 (as delineated by policy as the timeframe for the award).

Individual nominations are not necessary for the MacNamara award because all articles published in the three ACJS venues will automatically be considered.
