

Call for Associate Editor Applications

Corrections: Policy, Practice, and Research (CPPR) promotes methodologically rigorous scholarship on criminal sentencing, institutional confinement, community corrections, treatment interventions, alternative sanctions, and reentry. The journal prioritizes empirical studies that use quantitative, qualitative, or mixed-method research designs to advance correctional policy, practice, and research.

CPPR is currently soliciting applications for the position of Associate Editor. The chosen applicant will serve as Associate Editor for the journal for a three-year term from January 2027 through December 2029. The Associate Editor of the CPPR works directly with the Editor to perform the following tasks:

1. initial screening of manuscripts;
2. selection of reviewers;
3. promotion and improvement of the journal;
4. collaboration with editorial board members; and
5. assistance to guest editors with special issue preparation.

By agreeing to serve as Associate Editor, it is expected the chosen applicant will then serve as Editor of the journal for a three-year term from January 2030 through December 2032. The Editor and Associate Editor of the CPPR currently receive a yearly stipend from Routledge/Taylor & Francis.
